- 1. Commissioner Hansen was not in attendance.
- 2. The meeting was called to order by Mayor TenBroeck at 5:35 PM.
  - · Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Community Outreach: None
- 4. Consent agenda:
  - The motion to approve the consent agenda and October CRA meeting minutes was made by Commissioner Inks/ 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mayor TenBroeck. The motion carried with no objections.

#### 5. General Business:

#### A. 2021 Audit

- i. The Town Auditor, Brad Million, presented the 2021 audit. The audit was successful, no internal control deficiencies or compliance issues. Auditor Million suggests re-appropriating unused funds in budget to next years budget. Auditor Million stated that an additional audit would be needed for expensed funds exceeding \$100,000 in a fiscal year, which would cost approximately \$5-7k for the additional audit.
- The motion to approve the 2021 audit was made by Commissioner Inks/2nd by Mayor TenBroeck. The motion carried with no objections.
- B. CRA Financials Staff Report
  - Town Financial Manager Montgomery discussed the CRA quarterly funds and stated the CRA has recevied \$43k from Flagler County Board of County Commissioners for their 2022 contribution.
  - Financial Manager Montgomery stated a budget has not yet been approved for the fiscal year and will need to be addressed. Montgomery stated the unused funds from 2021 have been appropriated.
  - iii. Mayor TenBroeck discussed the draft budget and potential town improvements to include sidewalk lighting, lateral connection to the marina, exploration of infrastructure upgrades, the blight program, and pedestrian crossing.
- C. CRA Planning Discussion
  - i. Commissioner Inks discussed the Town's critical marina revenue and the \$1.2 million currently approved in grants, and how the Town is unable to move forward due to marina easement issues. Florida State Statues show the acquisition of real property is allowed. Planner Fleet states she will look into if the acquisition of real property is allowed in the Town's CRA Plan.
  - Attorney Bayer discussed that projects are typically a team effort and ranked by priority for the year, then proceed with funding and project improvements.



iii. Mayor TenBroeck suggests the Town hold a 1 hour CRA Workshop prior to the February regular Town meeting, to continue the discussion of future projects.

The next quarterly CRA meeting will be April 21, 2022 at 5:30pm.

The motion was made by Commissioner Inks/ 2nd Mayor TenBroeck. The motion carried with no objections. The meeting was adjourned at 6:08pm.
